Submit the original and two copies of the complete application.
This application should be typewritten, double-spaced, and limited to ten pages.

Each of the numbered items below should have the corresponding number on your application.

7. Date of birth and citizenship.
8. Names of dependents, if any, to accompany you if award is granted.
9. Educational History:
 - a. List in chronological order the institutions of higher learning that you have attended.
 - b. Give dates of attendance and degrees granted.
 - c. If you are now a candidate for a degree, name the degree, institution, and expected date of completion.
 - d. Applicants without a Ph.D. should request the institution at which they are currently enrolled to provide an official transcript, to be sent directly to ASOR by 1 April 2006.
10. Provide bibliographical citations of your scholarly publications. Do not send reprints or term papers.
11. Experience:
 - a. Describe scholarships, fellowships, and honors received, especially in teaching, research archaeological fieldwork, and other experience related to your project.
 - b. In the case of employment, provide names and addresses of employers, position titles, and dates of employment.
12. Expected dates and places of departure and return.
13. Duration of planned project. Give the cities or areas in which research will be conducted.
14. Full title of proposed research or study project.
15. Statement of proposed research program:
 - a. Give a full description of the intended research, including research itinerary.
 - b. State your qualifications for the proposed program.
 - c. Describe the final form you expect your research to take.
 - d. Your name should appear on each page of the statement.
16. Thesis or Dissertation: If the anticipated research is directly related to a thesis or dissertation in progress, describe the relationship.

17. Language competency in the primary language(s) of the area(s) in which research will be conducted.
18. Financial Resources:
 - a. List all other applications for financial support you have made in connection with the proposed research.
 - b. Give details of your plans to finance the balance of this project.
19. References: Give the names and addresses of three persons whom you have asked to write recommendations.
 - a. Their letters should be sent directly to ASOR.
 - b. They must comment on your academic qualifications for the proposed project.
 - c. If your proposal is closely related to your dissertation, request a recommendation from the advisor or first reader of your dissertation or from chairperson of your dissertation committee.
 - d. Arrange to have references sent to ASOR by the deadline for applications.
20. Statement of your intention to submit a report to ASOR within two months of the end of the award period. Should you receive an award, ASOR will supply guidelines for this report.
