ASOR KoboToolbox Module 01.06 – Collecting Data with an Internet

Connection

KoboToolbox is a free and open-source software package for collecting location and descriptive data. Information can be collected at heritage sites through tablets and phones using the KoboCollect app or through the web browser interface, even when those devices are offline. Location and descriptive data recorded in the field can then be synced with GIS software once an internet connection has been reestablished.

This **ASOR Tutorial (01.06)** outlines how to collect data through the Kobo website once you have finalized your project form. The steps in this tutorial work when you have an internet connection. This methodology works for all devices.


KEY CONCEPTS

- * Explore the Collect Data dropdown menu to choose how to collect responses.
- ❖ Understand that an entry is one completed submission using your form.
- ❖ Look for a confirmation message to ensure your entry was successfully submitted.

COLLECTING DATA WITH AN INTERNET CONNECTION

Using the Kobo website you can collect data on any device with internet. To collect without internet, you can use KoboCollect on an Android phone and tablet. Further information about KoboCollect and collecting without an internet connection can be found in modules 7 and 8. For this module, we will review the website with an internet connection.


1. Select **Sample Project 1.** Please ensure that the project is **deployed.** Select the **form** tab.




Data section of your project. Select

2. Open the drop-down menu in the **Collect** Online-Offline (multiple submission).


3. Select the **Open** link within the **Collect** Data section.







4. A new browser tab will open, displaying a blank data collection form. This form is only accessible if you have wifi.

5. **Enter data** into each field. Click **Submit** once you have finished. You will see a confirmation pop-up once the data has been **successfully sent**.





6. Return to your project and you will notice that the **Data** section is no longer grayed out. You can now access the data that you collected.
