Day 2 – Monday, 15 June | Nicosia

- [Shacolas Viewing Tower](#) – Panoramic views of divided Nicosia and its layered history.
- [Cyprus Archaeological Museum](#) – Collections from Neolithic to Late Antiquity, including figurines and sculptures.
- [Eleftheria Square & Historic Commercial Quarter](#) – Venetian, Ottoman, and British colonial urban layers; local shops.
- [Venetian Walls of Nicosia](#) – 16th-century fortifications defining the old city.
- [Leventis Municipal Museum of Nicosia](#) – Social and cultural history from antiquity to modern era.

Day 3 – Tuesday, 16 June | Larnaca & Amathus

- [Church of Saint Lazarus, Larnaca](#) – 9th-century Byzantine church over Lazarus's tomb.
- [Larnaca Medieval Castle](#) – Fortress with Byzantine, Lusignan, and Ottoman layers.
- [Hala Sultan Tekke](#) – Important Ottoman mosque and pilgrimage site.
- [Amathus – Roman Agora](#) – Ancient city-kingdom with Roman civic center.

Day 4 – Wednesday, 17 June | Kourion and Episkopi

- [**Kourion Archaeological Site**](#) – Greco-Roman city with dramatic coastal views.
- **Archaeological Museum of Kourion (Episkopi)** – Regional finds from domestic, religious, and funerary contexts.
- **Kourion Stadium** – Roman athletic facility illustrating public life.
- [**Sanctuary of Apollo Hylates**](#) – Archaic-to-Roman religious site.

Day 5 – Thursday, 18 June | Paphos

- [**Palaepaphos \(Kouklia\) – Sanctuary of Aphrodite**](#) – Cult center active from Late Bronze Age to Roman period.
- [**Paphos Archaeological Museum**](#) – Regional history from prehistoric settlement to Roman era.
- [**Paphos Harbour**](#) – Historical heart of the Roman city; free time for lunch.
- [**Paphos Archaeological Park – Roman Villas & Mosaics**](#) – Houses with mythological mosaics, including House of Dionysos.
- [**Tombs of the Kings**](#) – Hellenistic and Roman necropolis.
- [**Petra tou Romiou \(Aphrodite's Rock\)**](#) – Mythical birthplace of Aphrodite and coastal landmark.

Day 6 – Friday, 19 June | Neolithic Cyprus

- **Kalavasos–Agios Demetrios (Building 10)** – Late Bronze Age urban center in trade networks.
- [**Choirokoitia Neolithic Site**](#) – UNESCO World Heritage Site from the 7th millennium BCE.
- [**Lefkara Village**](#) – Traditional lace-making and silverwork; vernacular architecture.
- [**Limassol Archaeological Museum**](#) – Regional artifacts from prehistory to Roman period.

Day 7 – Saturday, 20 June | Troodos Mountains

- [**Troodos Mountains**](#) – Geological heart of Cyprus; ancient copper mining.
- [**Painted Churches in the Troodos Region**](#) – UNESCO-listed Byzantine frescoes.
- **Phicardou Village** – Traditional village with free time for lunch.
- **Skouriotissa Copper Slag Heap** – Evidence of extensive ancient copper production.

Day 8 – Sunday, 21 June | Bronze Age to Medieval

- [**Salamis, Cyprus**](#) – Ancient city from Late Bronze Age to Roman period.
- [**Enkomi \(Archaeological Site\)**](#) – Late Bronze Age urban center linked to copper trade.
- **Monastery of St. Barnabas & Museum** – Byzantine monastery with early Christian connections.
- [**Famagusta Old City**](#) – Medieval walls, Gothic churches, and Ottoman monuments.

Day 9 – Monday, 22 June | Kingdoms & Crusaders

- [**Vouni Palace**](#) – Persian-period palace reflecting Achaemenid influence.
- [**Kyrenia Castle & Shipwreck Museum**](#) – Medieval fortress with 4th-century BCE Greek merchant ship remains.
- **Bellapais Village & Lunch** – Scenic village with local cuisine.
- [**Bellapais Abbey**](#) – 13th-century Gothic monastery of the Lusignan period.

Day 10 – Tuesday, 23 June | Idalion & Larnaca

- [**Idalion \(Site and Museum\)**](#) – Ancient city-kingdom from Archaic through Hellenistic periods.
- [**Kition Temples, Larnaca**](#) – Phoenician and later sanctuaries.
- [**Larnaca Archaeological Museum & Bamboula**](#) – Material from ancient Kition and surrounding areas.
